## 2025-2026 Tuesday Night Yellow River Pool League

- 1. Entry fee is \$50.00. Pay at time of meeting. \$10 for trophies, \$40 for party per team.
- 2. Must be 21 or accompanied by a Parent.
- 3. If one or more balls are made on the break, table is open until a called ball is made.
- 4. Games will be played on Tuesday nights @ 7:00 pm (not bar time). There is a 15-minute grace period allowed. All makeup games can be played whenever both teams decide upon. But must be made up by the Tuesday after the last week of league play. So, plaques can be ordered, or time games can be played.
- 5. No combination shots on the 8 ball. After a player pocket's all his/her balls, he/she shoots the 8 ball, calling his/her shot so the opponent can hear it. If last ball is the 8 ball, it can be shot and go in called pocket to win.
- 6. Each player plays 3 games.
- 7. Scratch on 8 ball is automatic loss, Except on the break.
- 8. 8 ball on the break is not an automatic win, Breaking team will rerack and continue play.
- 9. All teams must consist of at least 5 players, or you forfeit. The lone player must rotate with a different player each game. Opposing team must choose a player that sits out.
- 10. Team captains must notify the opposing team of failure to appear 3 hours in advance unless weather conditions are such to make this notification impossible. It is between the two teams to decide whether to play if weather is bad.
- 11. Plaques for 1<sup>st</sup>,2<sup>nd</sup>
- 12. If a forfeit in 1<sup>st</sup> two weeks of play 5/0. No forfeit allowed in the last 4 weeks. All games must be made up.
- 13. Home team gets to break. Must racks your own break each game.
- 14. Money to be paid to winner from loser's pot is

- 15. Player who is shooting at the time, moves the cue ball any distance, will be ruled a complete shot except on the break.
- 16. Any ball moved accidently, opponent has the option of putting the ball on the spot or leaving it where it lies.
- 17. If the opponent moves the ball with his clothing, stick or whatever, he/she loses their shot, whether it is his/her ball or his/her opponents.
- 18. Any player double clutching on the 8 ball and makes a shot, loses the game. A miss will be considered his/her shot.
- 19. Any part of the ball in the kitchen, except the cue ball, will be considered in the kitchen and unplayable in the event of a scratch. Cue ball must be completely in kitchen in event of scratch.
- 20. Pool table to be cleaned and leveled prior to play time.
- 21. Opposing team may request the use of the table ½ hour before league starting time.
- 22. NO COACHING of players, except by partner at the table only.
- 23. PROTESTS: Captains Committee may be notified within 1 week of the game being protested.
- 24. If ball accidently drops in, the team captains will talk it over and decide what to do.

- 25. The Home Team is responsible for updating the scores on the Weisam.net website. This must be done no later than noon on Wednesday. Instructions for accessing this page are as follows:
  - In your browser Go to weisam.net
  - Scroll down to Pool Leagues
  - Select Yellow River League
  - Select UPDATE under Match Scores
  - Enter in your scores and hit submit
- 26. Forfeit team gets zero (0). Opposing team gets an average. Forfeiting team pays the opposing team \$12.00. Team average minimum is 5/4.
- 27. Team rotation will be 1-2-3, 2-3-1, 3-1-2 (visiting team only).
- 28. Play semi slop. Call each shot. The ball you call must go in the picket you call. Any way it goes in with a legal hit is good.
- 29. Home bar gives courtesy drink of what the person is drinking or of similar value.
- 30. No carry-ins, except for original roadie drink.
- 31. Party will be on the following Tuesday night after league ends.
- 32. Start time is 7:00pm, unless prior arrangements have been made. First game must start no later than 7:30pm.
- 33. If you are not allowed in a bar, you must have a sub or otherwise you forfeit the match.
- 34. Party and secretary will be at the bar in the rotation list. If the bar does not want to be secretary, they forfeit the party. It goes to next on the list. So far as follows:
