Granton/Chili Pool League Rules

1. Each team consists of Six players. All must be 21 or older. If one is absent, there can be a substitute, or you can rotate 3 of your 4 players in. The player who does not play the 4th game will be picked by the opposing team. A Player must play in the first ½ for the team, in order to be a sub in the second 1/2
2. Each team must have a captain. The captain is responsible for filling in the score sheets and reporting their pool scores at weisam.net website.
3. The fee is \$4.00 per player, \$24.00 Per team; \$48.00 total. Prize money; \$4.00 per game, \$16.00 for the table.
4. No coaching allowed, other than partners and away from the table.
5. Pool night will consist of 12 games, alternating breaks, visitors break first, rack your own break. Home team rotation stays the same. Visitors team rotation is 123,231,312,123.
6. Call you ball and pocket, this game is 8 ball straight in
7. Scratches, Ball in hand except on the Break; Scratch on the 8 ball does not loose unless the 8 is made.
8. Eight ball made on the break wins game. Eight ball made on the break and scratch loses game.
9. **Starting time is 7:00PM.** Team forfeits after 7:30PM without reasonable excuse. If team forfeits all 12 games, The other team will win their average, which can be no less than 7.
10. Regular 8 ball rules apply. Jump ball is ILLEGAL.
11. If any portion of the ball is over the line, it is considered in the kitchen. Cue ball must be behind the line.
12. If any ball is hit by accident, ball must be played from that spot
13. All score sheets must be completed and saved until the end of the season. If scores are not updated on Weisam.net teams will get a zero.
14. Any rescheduled games **MUST** be made up within 2 weeks. Rescheduled games must be agreed on by both team captains.
15. The table will be open until a player makes a called ball after the break.
16. Pool League will run 2 full rounds. Then Split into A&B divisions for the playoffs, each team will only shoot each other once.
17. One Minute time limit per shot!
18. Common Courtesy is to by the Visiting team a drink. If your home bar does not, do not expect to receive a drink from the others.
19. Common sense, no carrying your own drinks to drink while playing at opposing bars. They have all right to ask you to leave, which leads to you not being able to participate in shooting pool or darts.
